Manager's Corner

With the sudden trend of fur babies escaping, we'd like to share with you a few tips and tricks.

A trick to keep your pet from escaping under the fence is to outline the inside of your backyard fence with landscaping bricks.

A tip on making sure that your fur baby makes it back home safely would be to make sure that your contact info is engraved on your pet's collar.

If you notice a lost pet in housing with no info attached to the collar, snap a photo of it and send it to us. We'll post it on Facebook and email it as well. Unfortunately our office isn't equipped to house pets.

Maintenance Corner

When living in a very humid subtropical climate proper care of your HVAC system is vital. Below are tips on how to protect your a/c unit.

- Keep windows closed while unit is in use. This prevents the unit from overworking and decreases unwanted moisture in the home.
- Keep temperature settings consistent, 72 is the recommended lowest setting for optimal operation. Setting the system too low can cause the coils to freeze.
- Clean return grills regularly, to prevent dust from getting into your unit.
- A/C filters should be changed quarterly. Please ensure your contact information is up to date with our office, so you are notified when your home's filters are scheduled to be replaced.
