HUNT COMMUNITIES UPDATE

HMC is excited to make the below investments in our communities to improve the resident experience.

- Air Force Academy (\$1.35M) Pressure reducing valve infrastructure and tree removal.
- Ft Gregg-Adams (\$33M) Whole house renovation of 270-units in the Harrison Villa neighborhood.
- Columbus (\$980K) Roof replacement in Magnolia neighborhood and window replacement on impacted seals.
- Laughlin (\$200K) Window replacement on ~30-units, tree removal, and stormwater mitigation.
- Maxwell (\$630K) Tree removal, basement mitigations, and window replacement.
- Vance & Patrick (\$3.7M) Total roof replacement on ~400-units.
- Marine Corps Base Hawaii (\$31M) Interior renovations to 433 units in the Pa Honua Phase II and IV neighborhood.

As the weather continues to warm, please be aware that keeping grass within your fence and maintaining your flowerbeds is a responsibility agreed to in your lease. Keeping your grass trimmed also prevents insects, rodents and other wildlife from taking up residence in your yard and home.

Pressure washing of homes has started. We will send out notifications prior to the contractors starting work in your area. When notified please comply with the instructions to prepare your home for our contractors' arrival.

A Terminix service is an amenity afforded to our residents quarterly. Please take advantage of this great way to prevent insects from invading your home. Every 3 months, simply submit a routine work order in your app for pest control. South Carolina Spring can be an active time for growth and nature and Shaw AFB is no different. The better care you take now, the less headache you will have to deal with later.

COMMUNITY DIRECTOR'S NOTE

We are now in PCS season. Remember, we need to know when you are planning to leave us; whether you are PCSing, retiring, or otherwise separating from service. A written Notice to Vacate is a lease requirement.

- Shaw Family Housing requires a Notice to Vacate (NTV) of at least (30) days prior to departing from the home. Failure to comply will lead to additional termination fees at move out.
- To the best of your ability, please have a final date for departure in mind and a copy of your orders if you are PCSing, Separating, or Retiring; prior engagement with TMO is highly encouraged
